

Two walks into town

For those of you who are relatively new to Frome you might not have found alternative ways to walk into town other than along the busy main road. Here are two alternatives.

Along by the river



As you leave ASDA behind you, turn left at the roundabout and walk along to the traffic lights, at the junction of New Road and Warminster Road. Cross the road at the lights and continue straight ahead through the barriers (photo). This is the riverside walk and eventually leads to Rodden Meadow and then on to town via Willow Vale. Some houses here date back to the early 18th century. The walk ends on North Parade by the river bridge.

Through the houses



As you leave ASDA behind you, turn left at the roundabout and walk along to the traffic lights, at the junction of New Road and Warminster Road. Cross the road at the lights and go left and walk up towards the railway station. Go under the railway bridge and staying on same side of the road, cross the side road. After about 50 yards you will see a flight of steps by a lamp post. Go up these and just keep walking straight ahead until you reach Lidl's.
